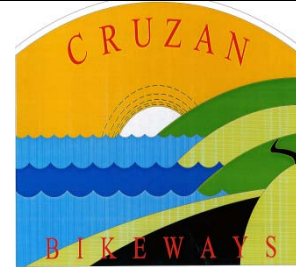




SECOND PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

ST. CROIX BIKE PATH



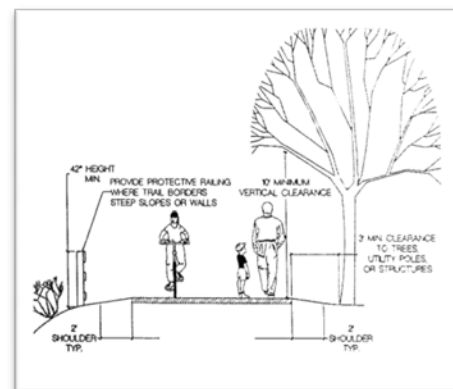
The US Virgin Islands Department of Public Works (USVI DPW) will host a second public information meeting for the proposed St. Croix (Cruzan) Bikeway along Route 62 Estate Humbug to Route 60 Southshore Road, and to Cramers Park. USVI DPW is conducting this meeting to inform citizens about the projects proposed action to permanently add bicycle and pedestrian facilities for health , fitness, and recreational and transportation facilities.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, December 9, 2010, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Virgin Island Department of Education Curriculum Center Conference Room (located west of Central High School and just east of the Superior Court) at # 3 VICORP Property, Kingshill, St. Croix, United States, Virgin Islands. This facility is accessible in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulation 23 CFR 771.105 section F and the American with Disabilities Act.

Greenways Incorporated will provide a project overview presentation beginning at 6:00 p.m. A short question and answer session will follow the presentation. Representatives from USVI DPW, Cruzan Bikeways Incorporated, and Greenways Incorporated will be available to informally discuss specific issues and answer questions during the open forum portion of the meeting.

The project consist of a 12' asphalt off- road shared use bike and pedestrian path within the public easements and rights – of ways of South Shore, from Hovensa Humbug Estate to Grassy Point.
